

Freddie Mac Prices \$703 Million Multifamily K-Deal, K-1508

MCLEAN, Va., Nov. 09, 2018 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- <u>Freddie Mac</u> (OTCQB: FMCC) recently priced a new offering of Structured Pass-Through Certificates (<u>K Certificates</u>), which are multifamily mortgage-backed securities. The company expects to issue approximately \$703 million in K Certificates (K-1508 Certificates), which are expected to settle on or about November 19, 2018.
